Business Banking

No matter how small your business, a Reliance Bank business account can help you manage your day-to-day transactions.

Business Current Account

You can pay salaries and set up standing orders and direct debits to pay bills from this account. What's more, with regular monthly statements, you'll have a complete record of income and expenditure. We can provide local paying in facilities through HSBC, Natwest, Lloyds TSB, Barclays and RBS, plus we are also able to offer a local encashment facility. A Visa Debit Card is available (subject to application).

Internet Banking

Our internet banking service, *i-bank*, offers you all the convenience of managing your account at any time of the day or night. Once your account is opened we will provide you with the necessary log in details to operate our secure service. You

can carry out a wide range of day-to-day transactions, including checking your balance, reviewing recent transactions, paying bills and transferring funds between Reliance Bank accounts.

Business Instant Access Account

Often, you find that you have surplus cash in your account that you'd like to put to better use - but you may also need to access the money at a moment's notice to cope with an unexpected bill. With a Business Instant Access Account, your money will be within easy reach at all times. At the same time, it can be earning interest for your business - right up to the moment when you need to meet a sudden expense. Interest is paid quarterly at the end of March, June, September and December.

Business Fixed Term Deposit Accounts

We have fixed term accounts ranging up to twelve months. These accounts offer a fixed interest rate guaranteed for the term of the deposit. Interest is paid on maturity of the deposit and a minimum balance of £50,000 is required to open this account.

Funds can be accessed through our counter services or by giving us electronic instructions via our internet banking service (*i-bank*) or written instructions to transfer money to another account elsewhere.

Charges

We are always hearing in the media that banks impose exorbitant charges on businesses to run an account. Here at Reliance Bank we offer an account to suit your needs, making sure you are not paying for the services you do not use. In this way we keep bank charges to a minimum.

These charges are reviewed on an annual basis and therefore it is always important to keep us up to date with your current business and any changes that could affect this financial review.

Lending

There are times when an overdraft facility may be required and we are happy to discuss your needs whether it is for a short term or longer (subject to application).

If you do go overdrawn without an agreed overdraft you could incur charges, as listed in our charges leaflet.

For any other type of lending for your business, call us and speak to one of our Relationship Managers who will be happy to discuss your requirements further. Lending fees and rates of interest will be discussed based on the type of lending, term and your business status.


